

BENCHMARK 2010 CONTRACTING REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION SUBCONTRACTORS

The following requirements apply to all applicants for a Benchmark subcontractors

1. Subcontractors must comply with the Department of Health & Welfare (DHW) Substance Abuse Program Standards. The current SAP Standards are available at [Idaho Substance Abuse Prevention Standards](#).
2. Subcontractors must complete and maintain Criminal History Checks (CHC) on all personnel working under this contract who will be in direct contact with minors or vulnerable adults. The CHCs must be conducted by DHW's Criminal History Unit, unless the individual delivers services *as part of their employment by a school district or law enforcement agency*. For these two agencies, the person must have had a background check within the past five years conducted by the Idaho Department of Education or Idaho State Police (as appropriate)
3. Subcontractors or their fiscal agents must maintain a minimum of \$1,000,000 in general liability insurance and must submit a Certificate of Insurance issued by a company that is registered to do business in Idaho.
 - Cities, counties, government agencies, tribes and school districts are required to add Benchmark as a Named Certificate Holder on their liability policy.
 - All other entities, commercial or nonprofit, are required to add Benchmark as an Additional Insured on their liability policy. Costs associated with this requirement may be included under Other Expenses in the Budget Worksheet.
4. Subcontractors must provide proof of Workers' Compensation in accordance with Idaho statutory limits. Workers' Compensation documentation expires annually and must be updated each State Fiscal Year.
5. Any Subcontractors awarded funding through this RFA will be required to:
 - Sign a contract with Benchmark Research & Safety, Inc. outlining the services to be delivered, the reimbursement rate per service, and performance requirements, including the collection of outcome data and participation in DHW's Qualified Prevention Professional Program.
 - Use the PreventionIdaho.Net data entry, program administration and invoicing system. Agencies without Internet service will need to make arrangements to obtain such services.
 - Prevention service(s) funded under this contract that are provided prior to the signing of the contract cannot be invoiced without prior written approval by Benchmark.
